Committee Updates

Communication & Newsletter: The committee asked the Board to submit ideas for newsletter articles, facilitate fact building and better contact.

Membership: Fields, Mike Helms, Nathan McBride, Anne Trapp, Justin Kozak and Mike Helms work on this.

Alleys: Entergy trimmed some of the alleys along power lines to prevent outages.

Welcome Packets: Heather delivered Champagne to Anne for the packets.

Dog Bag Stations: Create a place on the website for anyone to let us know that stations need a refill.

Drainage: The Storm Water Flood Plan has been presented at several public meetings. While the Garden District is not listed on any current projects, the designers are aware of the problems on some of our streets. (Cherokee and Tulip among others)

Signage: Catherine Leake has been decorating our signs and would like to know what her budget is. The Board would like her to know that she can spend enough to make them nice and would like to know what she needs.

Events: The committee will meet this summer. Anne has found some houses for the Champagne Tour. Clayton will help. Preston offered his house. Heather might be able to offer hers, depending upon her work schedule. It will be the day before Halloween. Costumes will be optional. Having a theme was suggested.

Live Oak Love Collective: Kimberly has done a great job. She was on **225** online. Clayton said that the City has noticed and is putting some money aside for maintenance of the trees. They

will probably need our contributions too. One Board member paid the city to have four trees in the median in front of his house cut for a very low price.

Babeth – Buy paper towels, bowls and utensils.

Michael and Chris – Buy heavy weight trash bags. Pick up and return tables and chairs to Mid City Redevelopment Alliance. Ask if they have trash barrels/cans.

Preston – Ask Eric Troutman about insurance Event Coverage.

John and Mike Helms – Lists of who are members and who has purchased tickets are needed for the crawfish boil registration tables. Some people don't remember if they are members. They pay dues when they are not.

Ashley (?): Create a place on the website to notify the Board that Dog Bag Stations are empty.

Jacob – Look into acquiring the use of a climate-controlled storage unit.

Claire – Put out more e-Blasts about the Crawfish Boil stressing that it will be on Saturday at a new location.
